### Scholarship Application for a Graduating High School Bowler

#### **ELIGIBILITY RULES**

Any graduating high school male or female who has been accepted as a candidate to a school of higher education (e.g. College, University, Vocational, Technical, etc.) is eligible to receive a scholarship providing the student meets the following requirements:

- A. Is a member of a league certified in the State of New York by the Southern Tier USBC and is in good standing for the current season.
- B. Has bowled a minimum of 21 games within the current bowling season.
- C. Files an application furnished by the Scholarship Committee giving complete information as required thereon, postmarked by **April 30th**. The application is to be filed with the Chair of the Scholarship Committee.

#### **SCHOLARSHIP AWARD**

The scholarships distributed through this program will be awarded to one male and one female bowler, and may be granted each year at the discretion of the Scholarship Committee. The monetary amount of the scholarships awarded is also at the discretion of the Scholarship Committee and Board of Directors. If an existing scholarship at any time is rejected, refused or the grantee becomes ineligible for any reason, the Scholarship Committee may grant the scholarship to another eligible applicant.

### **APPLICATION PROCEDURE** (To be completed by the Applicant)

Step #1	Completely fill out page 1, sign and mail to the Scholarship Chair by April 30th.
Step #2	Give your current league official page 2 of the application form. Ask the league official to completely fill out page 2 and sign. You or the league official must mail page 2 to the Scholarship Chair by April 30th.
Step #3	Give page 3 to the school official or your school counselor. Ask the school official or counselor to completely fill out page 3, sign and mail to the Scholarship Chair by April 30th.
Step #4	Check with your league official and school official or counselor in early March to make sure all the application papers have been completed. They MUST be postmarked by April 30th. Thank them for their cooperation and help.
