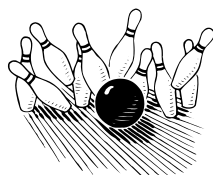

Adult Scratch Challenge Singles Tournament Rules

This tournament will be conducted on a SCRATCH basis and an entrant must be a USBC member of the current season.

1. All competition will be conducted on a SCRATCH basis (no handicap).
2. Walk-in entries allowed subject to lane availability.
3. All other bowlers shall report at least 30 minutes prior to the scheduled time for this event.
4. All bowlers shall be wearing appropriate attire for this event.
5. No entry fee will be refunded after the closing date.
6. The prize ratio will be at least one prize for every six entries. Prize fees are returned 100%.
7. In the event of a tie among the finalists, a 9th and 10th frame will be rolled to determine position or possible ultimate winner.
8. The decision(s) of the Tournament Committee shall be final unless an appeal is made in accordance with USBC rule 329. Rules 319a-2, 319d and 319e will **NOT** apply.
9. Official scorekeepers and/or monitors will be provided under the supervision of the Tournament Committee.
10. A bowler, while participating in this scheduled event, may be disqualified for the following:
 - a. An infraction of the rules.
 - b. Conduct derogatory to the best interest of the Tournament.
 - c. Consuming food or beverage in the bowling area.
 - d. Use of foreign substances which come in contact with the approaches of the lanes.
 - e. Use of cell phones in the bowling area.

TOURNAMENT FORMAT – Each bowler will roll four (4) games across four pairs of assigned lanes. The top five qualifiers will advance to a stepladder elimination format: #5 will bowl #4, the winner will bowl #3, the winner will bowl #2 and the winner will bowl #1 for the title.
